FATAL TRACTOR CRASH INVESTIGATION

On Sunday, August 18th, 2024, at approximately 8:50 a.m., Stephenson County Sheriff's Office personnel responded to the area of S. Kent Rd. and W. Kempel Rd. in rural Stephenson County for a report of a tractor rolled over and a subject pinned underneath. Upon arrival, deputies located a 22-year-old male deceased. There were no other persons or vehicles involved in the crash.

The results of the preliminary investigation revealed that an orange Allis-Chalmers tractor driven by Jacob Green, age 22, of Kent, had entered the west ditch of S. Kent Rd. just north of Kempel Rd. The tractor travelled down the steep embankment and rolled over pinning Jacob Green. As a result of being pinned under the tractor Jacob Green sustained fatal injuries. The crash is believed to have occurred during the early morning hours of August 18th.
