## FELONY CHARGES FROM SEARCH WARRANT EXECUTION

On Friday, August 8th, 2025, at approximately 1:45 p.m., the Stephenson County Sheriff's Office Crime Suppression Unit (CSU) and Emergency Response Team (ERT) executed a search warrant at a residence located in the 800 block of W. Stephenson St. in Freeport.

Upon entry, Jawon Stib (age 28), a resident of the target location, was taken into custody on an outstanding Stephenson County warrant for failing to appear in court on a charge of Possession with Intent to Deliver Cocaine 1-15 grams (court case 23CF36). At the time of his arrest on the warrant, Stib was found in possession of approximately 5.6 grams of suspected crack cocaine.

During a subsequent search of the residence, investigators located an additional 3.8 grams of suspected crack cocaine and a 9mm pistol. Following review by the Stephenson County State's Attorney's Office, Stib was charged with the felony offense of Possession with Intent to Deliver 1-15 grams of Cocaine. Stib was lodged at the Stephenson County Jail pending the outcome of a detention hearing.

The 9mm pistol recovered during the search is the subject of a separate, ongoing investigation to determine its lawful ownership and who may have possessed it. No charges related to the firearm have been filed at this time.
